Want a fun new twist on overshoot? Try using it as inlay ! During this class we will learn how to use overshoot to create areas of texture and interest in a woven piece. Over two weeks students will weave a small table runner or wall hanging featuring overshoot inlay as a design element. The goal is to have fun trying out a new technique and experimenting with different colors and textures.

Prerequisites for participants:

You don't have to be familiar with overshot as a woven structure. We will go over the basics of how to weave this fun family of drafts. However, you do need to be able to warp a floor loom and know how to read a draft.
