Description

This class will introduce participants to the types of inkle looms and the bands that can be woven on them. You will have the opportunity to explore patterns presented in a variety of reference materials, including books available in the Guild library. You will make string heddles to put on the loom, warp the loom and weave.

*We have a limited number of Inkle looms that may be borrowed from the guild. Guild looms may be taken home for up to two weeks if you want to finish your weaving. Non- members who borrow a guild loom must provide a refundable deposit of \$50 cash or check payable to Triangle Weavers Guild. The deposit is due at the class time and is refunded when the loom is returned. Please indicate if you would like to borrow a loom on the registration form.
